Day 1 - DEPART - Today we depart JFK on our overnight flight to Naples (via Rome) aboard a wide bodied jet. We will be served complimentary beverages, in-flight movies, dinner and breakfast aloft.

Day 2 – NAPLES/SALERNO - This morning we arrive in Naples Capodichino

Airport. We will be met by our tour manager and transferred to our hotel in Salerno, our host city.

Salerno is a city rich in history, art and culture. The rest of the day is free for exploring on your own. We will meet for a welcome drink before our dinner.

Overnight at our hotel.

Day 3 – BENEVENTO/AVELLINO - This morning after breakfast we drive to Benevento to visit the historic city center. Free time for lunch on your own. This afternoon we visit Avellino. Free time to explore on your own. Return to Salerno for dinner and overnight.

Day 4 - CASERTA ROYAL PALACE/POMPEII - This morning we depart for Caserta where we visit the Royal Palace. This famous Palace was built because Carlo III di Borbone Re delle Due Sicilie wanted to duplicate the Palace of Versailles. It was realized thanks to the intervention of the best architects and artists of the era, including Vanvitelli. Free time for lunch on our own. This afternoon we continue to Pompeii to visit the ruins. The city was buried by the ashes of Mt. Vesuvio in 79AD. We continue to the Basilica named Madonna Beata Vergine del Rosario di Pompeii this Basilica is a magnificent example of Ionic and Corinthian architecture. Return to Salerno for dinner and overnight.

Day 5 – NAPLES - This morning after breakfast we drive to Naples, the city most famous for its art, culture and gastronomy. We visit the Palazzo Reale, la Galleria, admire Piazza Plebiscito, Piazza San Domenico; il Cristo velato,

Piazza del Gesù, Chiesa del Gesù Nuovo, containing the remains of San Giuseppe Moscati. We complete this tour with a visit to the famous Monastero di Santa Chiara. Free time to shop or explore on your own, perhaps to most savour one of Naples' famous desserts Sfogliatella

Napoletana. Return to Salerno for dinner and overnight.

Day 6 - CAPRI/ANACAPRI - This morning we travel to Naples where we board our ferry to Capri. Morning sightseeing of Anacapri. Free time for lunch on your own. Afterwards we visit

Capri's piazzetta and the Augustus Gardens. Time for shopping and personal exploration. Late afternoon return by ferry to Naples. We board our motorcoach and return to Salerno for dinner and overnight.

Day 7 – SORRENTO/AMALFI COAST - This morning we depart for Sorrento. We visit the city center with free time to shop or explore on your own. We continue along the untamed beauty of this coast to reach the city of Amalfi, but not before we take a brief stop to take a picture of Positano. We visit the charming village Amalfi and its Cathedral. Free time for lunch on your own. Return to Salerno for dinner and overnight.

Day 8 - PAESTUM & COUNTRY HOUSE PAESTUM/AGROPOLI - This morning we drive to Paestum. Upon arrival we visit the ancient temples of the Greek colony and its museum. Lunch in a typical restaurant in Agropoli. This afternoon we return to Salerno for last minute shopping or to enjoy a stroll in town. A farewell dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Day 9 – NAPLES/USA – Arrivederci Salerno! this morning we will depart for Naples airport with memories that we will cherish for a lifetime.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

TOTAL TOUR PRICE: The tour price is based on airfare, cruise, land rates and rates of exchange in effect June 21, 2011. All rates are subject to change without prior notice. Should the rates go up or down, an adjustment would be made prior to departure. No refunds for any accommodations, services or events that are not used. If fewer than 20 passengers participate a price adjustment may be necessary.

PASSPORT AND VISA REQUIREMENTS: At the time of printing, U.S. citizens holding valid passports DO NOT REQUIRE visas or immunization for the country or countries being visited. Citizens of countries other than U.S.- MUST contact the consulate of the country or countries being visited to determine visa requirements.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: International flight reservations are being held on Alitalia. No stopovers are permitted. Any changes after ticket is issued, carries a mandatory charge of \$200. Once the tickets are issued, they are NON REFUNDABLE. Additional non-recoverable airline penalties of up to \$200 may be assessed for cancellations received within 90 days of departure

DOMESTIC AIRFARE: For those who make domestic air arrangements to the originating city of this tour, we strongly recommend the purchase of tickets that can be changed without heavy fees and penalties as international flight schedules are always subject to change.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS: Specially selected hotels based on twin occupancy with private bath. Single Room supplement of \$300 will be charged where requested and available. If you do not have a roommate and Unitours is unable to arrange one, you will be billed for the single room supplement. All singles are subject to availability.

MEALS: Breakfast and Table D' Hote dinners are provided daily except where noted in the itinerary. An extra charge will be made when coffee, tea or other beverages are not included in the menu of the day with the dinner meal.

TIPS AND TAXES: Tips and taxes normally appearing on hotel and restaurant bills as service are included, as are all government and local taxes, hotel portage of one suitcase per person if hotel provides such service. One average sized suitcase not exceeding 50 lbs total weight and 62 linear inches (height plus width plus depth) is permitted throughout the trip. **International departure taxes \$123 plus current fuel surcharges of \$420 are included. Tips to tour manager, drivers and dining rooms staff are not included.**

NOT INCLUDED: Expenses and items not specifically mentioned in this brochure are NOT covered, including but not limited to: passport and visa fees, meals not listed and items of a personal nature such as laundry, wines, liquors, mineral waters, after dinner coffee or tea, sightseeing or services other than those specifically mentioned, tips and taxes mentioned above, excess baggage and insurance, etc.

DEPOSITS AND CANCELLATIONS: A deposit of \$300 is required to secure reservations. Any balance is to be paid in full no later than 60 days before departure of tour. Final payments received by Unitours within 45

days prior to departure must include a \$25 late payment fee. Reservations made within 60 days of departure must include full payment.

Amex, Visa and Mastercard are accepted with signed reservation form. Final payments will be applied to same credit card on final payment due date. Cancellations made from time of reservation to within 61 days prior to departure -- \$100 processing charge plus any air penalties noted above. In the event of a cancellation from 60 to 8 days of departure --\$150 processing charge plus up to 50% of the land cost, plus any air penalties noted above. No refund for cancellations received within 7 days of departure. All cancellation and refund claims must be in writing to Unitours, Inc.

DEVIATIONS: A service charge of \$50 pp will be applied for any deviations made in tour, (where possible), PLUS any additional air or land charges incurred.

LAND ARRANGEMENTS: The tour operator reserves the right to change the itinerary due to unforeseen emergencies.
